Primary Duties and Responsibilities

- Serves as a Christian example of fair play and good sportsmanship both on and off the playing field and court. Emphasize the glory of God over school and self.
- Conducts a pre-season meeting with parents of student-athletes who are participating in the given sport, and distributes a copy of team guidelines, coach's expectations, and practice and game schedules.
- Teaches, trains, and develops athlete's skills and fundamentals.
- Organizes and executes practice sessions in conjunction with practice times coordinated with the athletic director.
- Provides supervision for student-athletes after practices and games until they are picked up by a parent or guardian.
- Attends all games and is responsible for the conduct of the team.
- Communicates new equipment needs known to the athletic director prior to St. John Ministries fiscal year budgetary meeting and cares for existing equipment used in the sport coached.
- Acquires signed medical release and liability forms for all practices and games for each athlete in conjunction with the nurse's office and athletic director.
