Council Meeting Minutes Monday, December 18, 2023

In Attendance: Reid Ehrisman, Sara Anderson, Mike Anderson, Pastor Joe Leech, Karen Grant, Vince Hoehne, Pastor BJ Fouts, Jessica Fouts, Kelsey Schnoor, Deanna Anderson, Steven Whitney, Colby Kolm, Katie Schnitzler, Brett Freudenburg, and Nick Onnen

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Reid Ehrisman at 8:02 pm. Reid opened with a devotion and prayer.

Mike Anderson made a motion to approve the November 20, 2023 council meeting minutes. Second by Jessica Fouts. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report by Katie Schnitzler. Budgeted income continues to increase compared to last year. All expense items remain lower than last year at this time except for things out of our control like building maintenance/repair items, minimum wage hikes, and employee benefit plan costs. The current balance of operating debt is \$157,009.86 with that balance likely continuing to increase. This current fiscal year started with \$247,009.86 in operating debt. With school registration money, a portion of that balance was paid down in July and August, but now we are in the phase of the year where we need those funds for operating costs. Mike Anderson made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Karen Grant seconded. Motion carried.

Trustees' Report. None.

Elders' Report: by Mike Anderson. The elders are doing their part to monitor expenses and stay under budget. On November 29 the Elders served soup for the Advent meal. A total of \$194 was raised from that meal. Both Pastors have been busy. Pastor Fouts has announced that he is "pausing" the deliberation of his call until after the holidays. Please continue to keep him and his family in your prayers.

Evangelism Report by Sara Anderson. Evangelism served french toast bake with Parish Ed for the Advent meal on December 13. They served about 75 people. Evangelism continues to serve coffee and treats on Sunday mornings following worship. They will always take extra treats to stock the freezer. Evangelism will look into "re-vamping" the missionary information board in the narthex.

Parish Ed Report by Jessica Fouts. Parish Ed hosted the french toast bake meal with Evangelism for Advent. The funds raised from the meal are for VBS t-shirts. They want to be able to purchase a t-shirt for every child participating in VBS this coming July. Parish Ed packed bags to hand out at the Family Christmas worship service this past weekend. Postcards have been sent to college students with information on church services over the holidays. There are still quite a few of the older college students for whom they have no address information. Please contact the church office or a parish ed board member if you have information on any of these students. Parish Ed's goal for the year is to enhance our congregation's ministry from birth to death.

Parochial Ed Report by Brett Freudenburg. Mrs. Eriksen is finishing her colloquy certification. Mrs. Kollbaum is finishing her master's degree. The basketball team is getting new uniforms funded by the athletic fund. The board members are working on finishing up their classroom visits. The board finalized their requests for the endowment fund distribution. The gym floor is still at a stand-still. It is being used for practices, but not for games. There has still not been a report back from the investigator regarding his conclusions on the issue with the floor. Nick will continue to contact the investigator until an answer has been received.

Early Learning Center (ELC) Report by Deanna Anderson. Staffing updates – Hannah B. will be doing her internship in January so they will need to replace a full-time school age teacher. They are still working on the playground design with contractors to make it ADA compliant. The ELC held a Butterbraid fundraiser that gave them a profit of \$3,500. Those proceeds will go towards the playground fund. The ELC is looking into doing a "spring spectacular". There will be more information to come on that. Kelsey will be starting her master's program in January to get her Admin. in Special Ed. degree. The board talked about Endowment Fund and their requests for the distribution for 2024.

Stewardship Report by Karen Grant. The total raised for the Day of Giving was \$13,020. Stewardship served 90 people for the Advent meal on December 6 (up from last year) and raised about \$165. For consecration in January, Stewardship will be serving cookies and coffee after church on Saturday, January 27 and brunch from 10:30 am – 12:00 pm on Sunday, January 28. Neal Acklie has agreed to serve a 5-year term on the Endowment committee.

Mike Anderson started a discussion regarding the church parking lot usage. The lot becomes full when there are simultaneous activities at the public school. Mike will get estimates for a sign that reads "lot closed to public" or "church event parking only" with interchangeable wording that can be put up during church events. This way it would be reserved for church parking only. Mike is also looking at getting a "Welcome, we're glad you're here" stamp for the cement in front of the parish hall doors. These items will be discussed with the trustees at next month's meeting.

Old Business - None.

New Business – Approval of Non-Taxable Allowances for Rostered Workers in 2024

The business manager reported the proposed percentages for each rostered worker. The list will be attached to the official copy of the council minutes. Rostered employees must meet 3 "tests" to achieve this classification. These percentages don't change what we pay our workers. It's just a classification for W-2 reporting. The first test is that these percentages are approved in the minutes. The other 2 tests fall personally on the individual. Mike Anderson made a motion to approve the request for non-taxable allowances for the rostered workers. Second by Karen Grant. Motion approved.

Other – None.

Next Meeting January 15, 2024 at 8:00 pm.

Brett Freudenburg made a motion to adjourn. Second by Deanna Anderson. Motion carried.

Pineapple Pretzel Fluff ~ Submitted by Christy Schmitz

Ingredients

- 1 cup coarsely crushed pretzels
- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 1 cup sugar, divided
- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- 1 can (20 ounces) unsweetened crushed pineapple, drained
- 1 carton (12 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed



Directions

Preheat oven to 400°. Mix pretzels, melted butter and 1/2 cup sugar. Press into a 13x9-in. pan. Bake 7 minutes. Cool completely on a wire rack. Meanwhile, in a large bowl, beat cream cheese and remaining sugar until creamy. Fold in pineapple and whipped topping; refrigerate, covered, until serving. To serve, break pretzel mixture into small pieces and stir into pineapple mixture.
